

Work Agreement

This agreement is between the Indian Lake Improvement Association and one of its members, for a shoreline stabilization project at the Homeowner's shoreline.

The Association agrees to	The Homeowner agrees to
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Provide triaxle loads of revetment riprap to the Homeowner at its cost• Provide a delivery/deployment site for the riprap at North Beach• Provide unsupervised labor at the rate of ten dollars per hour per laborer• Provide use of the Association workboat by its workers for transportation of the riprap to the Homeowner's shoreline• Provide itemized billing to the Homeowner for materials and labor	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Communicate to the Association when a load of riprap should be ordered and when the work should take place• Provide supervision to the laborers• Pay the invoices for materials and labor within 7 days of receipt

The Association makes no claims of expertise for its workers, and makes no guarantees for how well the stabilization will work. The Homeowner is responsible for supervising how the work is done, and the results.

If the Homeowner fails to pay in a timely manner, work will be stopped and any remaining riprap at North Beach will become the property of the Association. The delinquency will be treated in the same manner as delinquencies for annual assessments.
